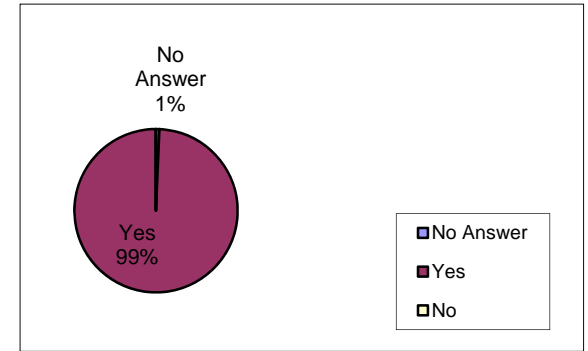

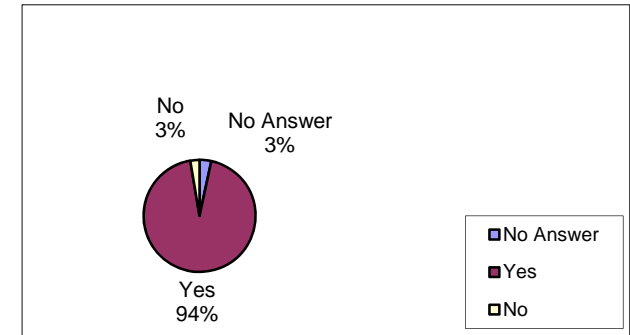

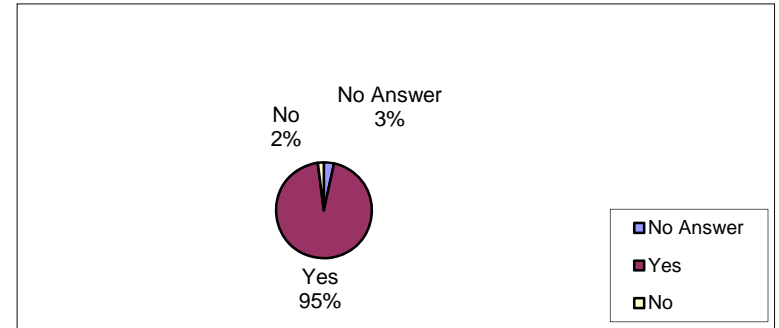
**Activity Conveyed Information To Assist Improving Patients' Health**

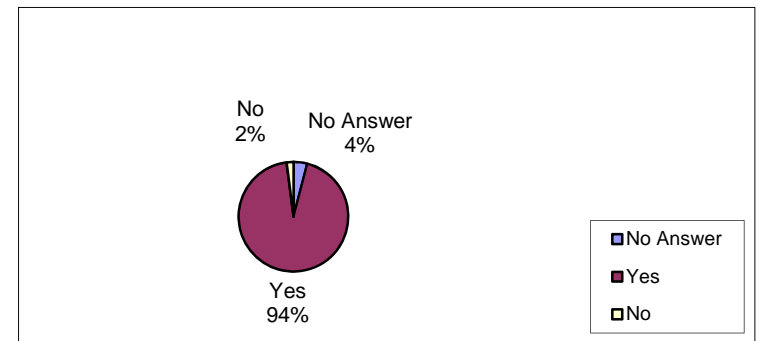
**Names of Commercial Supporters Were Related to the Audience**

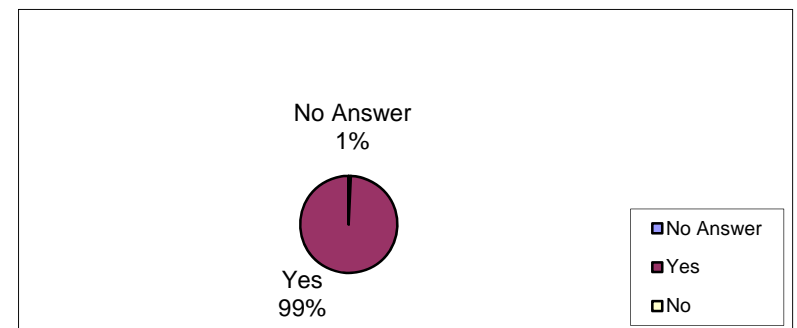
**Conflict Of Interest Was Conveyed to Audience**

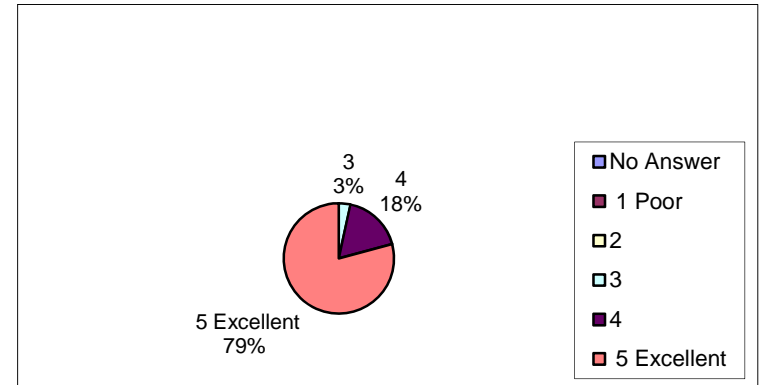


**Were Presentations Free from Commercial bias?**

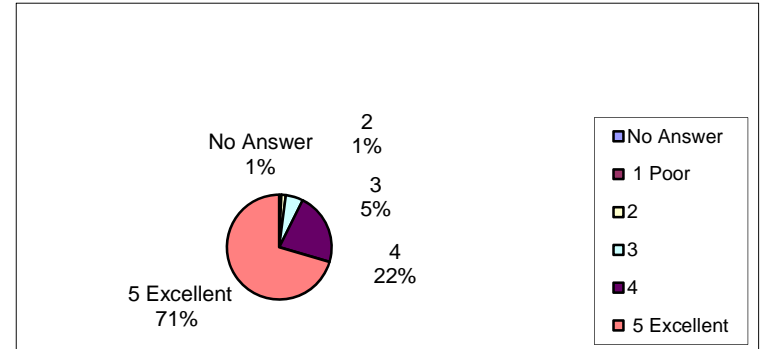
